4.1. ABC Migration

ABC has scheduled a migration that will explicitly disable support for all versions prior to Release N.N. Please note that this action includes formally dropping support to Release N.N. Our plan is to implement the new protocol restrictions in a phased approach. User and integrations who do not support the secure configuration will no longer be able to connect to Release N.N.

5. Functional Enhancements

5.1. Bug # - Exit Row Specification in Seat Map

Some planes do not have exits on both sides, AAA has defined a new set of codes to specify the location of exits in aircraft rows.

- AA - The exit is on the right side of the aircraft
- BB - The exit is on the left side of the aircraft
- CC - The exit is on both sides of the aircraft

The ABC API has been updated to accommodate these codes.

The following optional attribute has been added to the ABC <API Name> response schema. When present in an <API Name> message, the attribute will return any of the three code values (AA, BB, CC) defined above.

<API Name>/<Node Name>/<Component Name>/@<Attribute Name>
